Your application will automatically be submitted for consideration for the Governor's 100 year District Anniversary Scholarship program (2016-2017). *The cut-off date of July 15, 2017. \*Applicant shall be recognized as Awardees at the 2016-17 Kiwanis District Convention, August 24-27, 2017, in Kennewick, Washington.*

**Qualifications**

1. Applicants must be an active member for two years and be in good standing with their Division home club, District, and International.
2. Has paid dues and appear on the roster on file at Key Club International.
3. Is a graduating High School Senior.
4. A college, university, technical, or vocational school-bound student.
5. Has a grade point average of at least a "B" average or equivalent grade point of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale.
6. Has attached an official high school transcript with an explanation of the grading system utilized.
7. Submits the District application and the backup information to the Pacific Northwest Foundation Chair by the above deadline established by the District.
8. For more information contact you Key Club Administrator.
9. 2016-2017 only; all Key Club scholarship applications shall automatically enter the Governor's 100 year scholarship program.

**Application Procedures**

All Applicants must submit the following:

- a) Completed application form and mailed with posted dated before the above stated deadlines.
- b) List all Key Club offices held and attendance of leadership events; selected or appointed positions at the Division club, District or International level.
- c) List any District/International conventions, training conferences, or leadership events attended.
- d) Campus Organizations and activities

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- e) Religious and community Activities.
  - f) Honors, wards and special recognitions
  - g) One (1) letter recommendation that describes your leadership ability from a Kiwanis Club member or community leader, or religious leader.
  - h) One (1) letter from your Key Club Advisor verifying your leadership and listed activities and stating years of membership and dues are current.
  - i) The reference letters must be no more than two (2) pages in length, and they must be Original letters that are Dated and Signed by your References.
  - j) Attach a Certified copy of your official high school transcript with an explanation of the grading process utilized at the school.
  - k) All of the above must be included with your application, to be considered.
1. The application must be postmarked no later than February 1<sup>st</sup>, or July 15<sup>th</sup> for the Governor's Scholarship Program.
  2. The applications and letters listed above must be submitted to Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation Scholarship Chair: Margie Wilson, 1504 Melissa Way, Wenatchee, WA 98801.

**Other Information**

A committee from the Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation shall determine the recipients of each scholarship.

1. All scholarships are provided in the form of checks issued to the College or University and Technical School. The recipient of the scholarship must verify their enrollment through the College Registration office with a signed **"Student Enrollment Verification Request"** and send to *Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation, Mike Mohan, Treasurer, 106 N Main Street, Prineville, Oregon 97754*
  - a) All PNWKF checks will be sent directly to the College for deposit into the Students Account.
  - b) Checks are disbursed by the Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation Treasurer upon receiving the "Student Enrollment Verification Request" signed by college of your choice.
2. Recipients of Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation Scholarships are announced at the Key Club District Convention (DCON) your attendance would be highly appreciated.
3. Key Club membership is verified with Kiwanis International Office.
4. All application materials received by the Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation shall become the property of the PNWK Foundation and will not be returned.
5. All Scholarships must be applied to your college of choice by the deadline date of October 1st, of the following year.
6. The Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation Board reserves the right not to make an award if, in the Board's judgement, there are no qualified applicants.
7. The Governor's 100 year Anniversary District Scholarship applications can be submitted after February 1<sup>st</sup> till Cut-off date of July 15, 2017.
